On June 1, publishers, producers, and narrators gathered in Rockefeller Center's famous Rainbow Room for the Audies[®] black-tie gala honoring the year's best audiobooks. Jim Dale was master of ceremonies as the Audio Publishers Association (APA) presented winners in 32 categories, including three new categories—Thriller/Suspense, Children's Titles for Ages 12+, and Spanish Language—and this year's special Judges' Award for Politics.
